

Region 6 Cycling Team Qualification Races -Town of Boston

Open to permanent NYS residents of Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie, Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Niagara, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Steuben, Wayne, Wyoming and Yates Counties.

REGISTRATION: ONLINE ONLY at www.empirestategames.org \$10

TIME & PLACE: 7:00-8:00 AM Boston Fire Hall, Mill St. & Boston-State Rd.

RACE DAY FEES: additional \$10 on top of the \$10 paid to the state. You MUST have a current USCF

license or the purchase of a one-day license is required.

RACES: A 6.1 mile **Time Trial** will precede the **Road Races** for OPEN competitors only. 8:00 am start. Road Race start to be 30 minutes after the finish of the last Time Trial.

OPEN MEN - 6.1 mi. TT and 48 mi. RR- 10 to qualify (Juniors/Masters may try to qualify) OPEN WOMEN - 6.1 mi. TT and 38 mi. RR - 3 to qualify MASTERS 45, 55, ROAD RACE ONLY 38 mi. - 3 pl./ medals ea. (non-qualifying race)


Race lengths may be changed subject to conditions on race day. USCA Permit #2010-1831. USCF Rules will apply. Points will be awarded for final placing in both TT and RR and intermediate sprints. Top 10 Men and Top 3 Women point getters in Open categories Qualify for Team. Scoring will be per "Competitions in stage races on points" Rules (see 2010 USCA rulebook). Riders Must compete in Both TT and RR to qualify. In addition, to finish placing points for both the TT and RR intermediate sprint points will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place across the line on the first and second laps of the RR (3, 2, and 1 respectively). Course will be open to traffic at all times.

Directions to registration at the **Town of Boston Fire Hall (registration will open at 7:00am)**:

From the East - NYS Thruway to Exit 55 (US-219) South to Boston Exit (NY 391). Turn left at light onto Boston State Rd.

Follow Boston State approximately 5.75 miles to the caution light at Mill St. (Look for the Boston Hotel/Deli, etc. at intersection.) Turn right to the Fire Hall.

From the West – NYS Thruway Exit 57 (Hamburg). Take NY 75 through the village until it meets NY 391. Follow 391 South . . . becomes Boston State Rd. After passing the US 219 exit, follow directions above.
